



BEHAVIOUR MANAGEMENT: LOW LEVEL INCIDENTS

We are very proud of the behaviour of the children at Child's Play. Incidents of bad behaviour are incredibly rare and are always dealt with swiftly and appropriately by staff so they do not become a problem. However, low level incidents will always happen from time to time in any Early Years setting, indeed they are a normal part of children learning the social norms of behaviour.

We want to ensure we involve you in our strategy for dealing with these incidents. We will feed back to you when these incidents have taken place and have involved your child. We will issue you with a slip of paper notifying you if your child has been – for example – pushed by someone. Likewise if your child has – for example – pushed another child you will also be notified. If the incident requires the physical intervention of a member of staff you will also be notified, and a record will be kept. These notifications are just for information, they do not necessarily mean there is anything to be concerned about.

This does not affect the normal accident reporting whereby if a child is hurt you are informed and it is reported in the accident book.
